# POISON IVY

There are 3 forms of poison ivy you may encounter during your cleanup.

Plant



Vine



Bush



Poison ivy can be identified by its distinct bunches of 3 leaves. It can be found as a free standing plant, a vine climbing up a tree, or as bushy growth. Its leaves can be almond shaped, and some have jagged edges or lobes, while others are relatively smooth.

Because all parts of a poison ivy plant can cause a rash, you should avoid touching the leaves, stems, vines or roots of all poison ivy plants.
