Mobile Meth Labs

Police are finding increasing numbers of mobile meth labs.

If you find what appears to be a meth lab

ALERT YOUR SITE COORDINATOR IMMEDIATELY

Common items found at meth labs include:



Discarded coolers with various chemicals



Bottles with tubing or hoses



Boxes of various chemicals

Cold pill packages in large quantities

Flammable solvents in large quantities

Crystal Draino

Hydrogen peroxide

Iodine

Drain opening chemicals

Lye

Muriatic acid

Coffee filters or paper towels with unusual stains

Propane tanks with corroded brass fittings

Isopropyl alcohol

Homemade pipe fittings on tanks or thermoses

Empty Coleman fuel tanks

Empty lithium battery packs

Empty bottles with sludge type residue

Volunteers should not touch any hazardous material. If you find any of these items or anything that looks suspicious,
